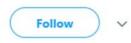

# Why may blockchain be such a disruptive technology?



#### **The Promise**

Beyond internet and cryptographic details: A database – as there are many, including in elections

#### **But:**

- traditional databases are run by organizations: EMBs, observers, governments, banks
- blockchain is data on a "public ledger" run by "miners" in "the cloud"



#### The Promise

No single institution that needs to be trusted

No single institution that can manipulate data

No single institution that can be hacked

A system that can be jointly owned and run



### The Promise – it even works

e.g. for multi billion financial transactions without banks

- Results data

Even if the blockchain system works – how does what data get in and out?



# The Reality

Online voting usually seen as most promising application

Generally slow progress on online voting globally

Only small pilots so far

Applications in observation now emerging – also in Indonesia
